MARC NAGTZAAM

Biography

Marc Nagtzaam (1968, Helmond, The Netherlands). Drawing is his medium of choice; his aim is organizing a picture plane that, in its apparently irretrievable austerity, is, nonetheless, equally hermetic and contingent. Most of Marc Nagtzaam's drawings consist of colourless, darkly filled in graphite surfaces. Abstracted elements from architecture, graphic design, details from found photographs, or parts from previous drawings are starting points for every series of works. This source material is being reduced, with basic, elementary means: dots, lines and flat surfaces, to construct a sort of structure. As Nagtzaam himself points out: "I'm looking for representations of a (seemingly) concrete reality as well as I search for images which can only exist as a drawing."
