Biography

Morrosko Vila-San-Juan (Barcelona, 1970), Filmmaker & Journalist

Bachelor in Philosophy and Literature, has worked as a journalist, screenwriter and film producer (cinema and television), his main activity has been focused in direction. In his filmography he accounts for short films, documentaries, videoclips, transmedia format and several television programs including "Version Española" (TVE) and "Trailer" (BTV), obtaining a special mention in the "Ciutat de Barcelona" awards.

His most recent work includes "Barcelona era una fiesta (Underground 1970-1980)", opening the In-Edit 2010 festival which can be viewed in Filmin.es; "Terra d'oportunitats" awarded for its international projection in the Most Festival and awarded as best documentary at the swiss festival Oenovidéo 2012. Recently has directed "Valors", a documentary about social labor and environmental reinsertion for TVC, driven by Obra Social La Caixa y Diputació de Barcelona.

One of his most recent project is #ObjetivoSalud, a series of documentaries driven by ISGlobal (Barcelona Institute for Global Health) for TVE and Planeta Futuro (El País), about the fight against poverty and the leading causes of death in the world.

He has also directed and produced audiovisual for various brands and institutions.

Finally, he collaborates with La Vanguardia, in the supplement Cultura/s, with reports about the audiovisual landscape. He also teaches in the Master of Digital Communication and the Master of the Audiovisual Postproduction of UAO and Bachelor of Journalism of UIC.
