Biografia

Antonella Montes, **Lantomo** (Roma, 1977) va estudiar Arquitectura en la Universitat de Roma i és artista i il·lustradora autodidacta. Actualment resideix a Barcelona, on ha realitzat el Màster en Arquitectura, Art i Espai Efímer en la UPC i va presentar les seves primeres exposicions en Mitte Art Space i en Mutu Centre d'art, entre altres.

Després d'una llarga temporada a la Xina que va influir molt en el desenvolupament de la seva tècnica, va decidir lliurar-se a la seva passió. Ha experimentat el contrast de cultures entre Orient i Occident, i això ha ajudat i inspirat la seva creació artística. Els seus dibuixos tracten de revelar petits misteris, pors i sorpreses amagades en l'ànima, difícils de veure si no es presta una atenció absoluta. El dibuix és la seva eina d'expressió, amb tota la paciència i la labor que això implica, directe i accessible en la seva falta d'abstracció. Les cares i els ulls dels seus personatges són els seus vectors de comunicació.
